Equine Dry Needling Schachinger Method®

Dry Needling is a physical therapy that was invented in the USA in the middle of the last century. Since then, medical research has gained more and more insight into the effects of needling painful muscular structures. Caused by trauma, one-time or chronic overload, inappropriate biomechanical or metabolic stress the small muscle fibres can indurate or adhere.

This leads to little knots – the so-called trigger points - that interfere with healthy muscle function. Via the connective tissue – the fascia – which structures and cross-links the whole body, pain and loss of function are emitted to other body areas.

Whole muscle trains can be affected this way – by a single trigger point. This is called the myofascial pain syndrome. Manual treatments are often insufficient in this case. The solution: Dry Needling. After precise localization, acupuncture needles are inserted to revive the trigger point area from its neurophysiological rigor mortis. The displacement of tissue as well as the biochemical reactions to the penetration into the triggerpoint lead to the reactivation of the inactive are. The muscle goes back to its healthy ability for stretching and contraction.
